

ASH UNITED FC WAS FOUNDED IN 1911 AND STARTED PLAYING MATCHES AT ASH COMMON.

THEY SOON BECAME WELL ESTABLISHED IN THE SURREY INTERMEDIATE LEAGUE, WINNING EVERY HONOUR POSSIBLE. AFTER THE SECOND WORLD WAR ASH UNITED RESTRUCTURED AND THE 1947/48 SEASON WAS THE MOST SUCCESSFUL IN THEIR SHORT HISTORY, WINNING THE LEAGUE CHAMPIONSHIP AND FOUR-CUP COMPETITIONS.

THEY THEN HAD TO WAIT UNTIL THE 1966/67 SEASON FOR THEIR NEXT SUCCESSFUL CAMPAIGN WHERE THEY DOMINATED THE SURREY INTERMEDIATE PREMIER "A" LEAGUE. THE TITLE WAS WON WITH ONLY TWO POINTS DROPPED OUT OF A POSSIBLE FIFTY-TWO. THIS INCLUDED A LONG UNBEATEN RECORD WITH 121 GOALS FOR AND ONLY 19 AGAINST

MORE RECENTLY

WE INTERGRATED WHAT WAS FORMERLY KNOWN AS JUNIOR SHOTS TO ASH UNITED YOUTH FC WITH OVER 300 CHILDREN FROM U5 TO U16 PLAYING ACCROSS THE SURREY YOUTH, HANTS & BERKS LEAGUES. WE HOPE THIS CEMENTS A PATHWAY FOR YOUNG PLAYERS TO PROGRESS INTO THE FIRST TEAM

THE RESERVE TEAM FOLLOWED SUIT WINNING THE DIVISION "A" TITLE SCORING 137 GOALS IN ONLY 26 GAMES. WITH THE CLUB HAVING A STRONG SQUAD OF PLAYERS, PROMOTION TO THE SURREY SENIOR LEAGUE WAS ACHIEVED IN 1968. FINISHING RUNNERS UP IN BOTH THE LEAGUE AND THE CUP IN THE FIRST SEASON THEIR FIRST SPELL IN THE SURREY SENIOR LEAGUE CAME TO AN END IN 1971 WHEN BEING FORCED TO CHANGE GROUNDS. ASH UNITED WERE RE-ADMITTED TO THE SURREY SENIOR LEAGUE WHEN A NEW PERMANENT GROUND WAS FOUND, WHICH HAPPENS TO BE THE CURRENT GROUND AT YOUNGS DRIVE. THE SMURFIT KAPPA STADIUM THE NEXT SUCCESSFUL SEASON WAS 1977/78. THEY WON THE CHARITY CUP BEATING DORKING 2-1. THE FOLLOWING SEASON THEY WERE RUNNERS-UP IN BOTH THE NEWLY NAMED COMBINED COUNTIES LEAGUE AND THE PHILIPS FOOTBALL FLOODLIGHTING CUP COMPETITION.

THE APPOINTMENT OF OUR NEW FIRST TEAM MANAGER - OUR RESERVES & UIBS ARE RUN BY THE COACHING TEAM (ALEX JUSTIN JOSH & PAUL) MOVE TO THE ALDERSHOT AND DISTRICT LEAGUE - OUR UIB PLAYING IN THE ALLIED COUNTIES UIB MIDWEEK LEAGUE - OUR NEWLY FORMED ASH UNITED WOMEN (MANAGED BY DAN & BLAINE) PLAY IN THE WOMENS SOUTHERN COMBINATION LEAGUE AND WE ALSO HAVE A NEW VETS TEAM RUN

THE CLUB WAS ESTABLISHED IN 1938 BY WORKERS OF THE HAMBLE-LE-RICE AIRCRAFT FACTORY UNDER THE NAME FOLLAND AIRCRAFT. THE CLUB WON THE HAMPSHIRE SENIOR CUP IN 1940 41.THE FOLLOWING SEASON SAW THE CLUB WIN THE HAMPSHIRE LEAGUE AND THE HAMPSHIRE FA'S RUSSELL COTES CUP. BY 1948 THE CLUB HAD LEFT THE HAMPSHIRE LEAGUE AND WERE ALSO RENAMED FOLLAND SPORTS. IN 1968 THEY RE-JOINED THE HAMPSHIRE LEAGUE, BECOMING MEMBERS OF DIVISION THREE EAST.

WHEN LEAGUE REORGANISATION IN 1971 SAW THE REGIONAL THIRD DIVISIONS REPLACED WITH DIVISION THREE AND DIVISION FOUR, FOLLAND SPORTS WERE PLACED IN DIVISION THREE. HOWEVER, IN 1975 76 THEY FINISHED SECOND-FROM-BOTTOM OF DIVISION THREE AND WERE RELEGATED TO DIVISION FOUR. IN 1979 80 THE CLUB WERE DIVISION FOUR CHAMPIONS AND MOVED UP TO DIVISION THREE AS DIVISION FOUR WAS DISBANDED; THE SEASON ALSO SAW THEM WIN THE HAMPSHIRE INTERMEDIATE CUP. THEY WON DIVISION THREE THE FOLLOWING SEASON, EARNING A SECOND SUCCESSIVE PROMOTION, THIS TIME TO DIVISION TWO. IN 1985 86 THE CLUB WERE DIVISION TWO RUNNERS-UP AND WERE PROMOTED TO DIVISION ONE. THE FOLLOWING SEASON SAW THE CLUB WIN THE SOUTHAMPTON SENIOR CUP WITH THE FINAL BEING PLAYED AT THE DELL.

IN 1990 THE CLUB WERE RENAMED AEROSTRUCTURES S&S. IN 97-98 THE CLUB WON THE WESSEX LEAGUE CUP. AT THE END OF THE SEASON THEY ADOPTED ANOTHER NEW FACTORY LINKED NAME, THIS TIME BECOMING HAMBLE ASSC. WHEN THE WESSEX LEAGUE GAINED A SECOND DIVISION IN 2004 THE CLUB BECAME MEMBERS OF DIVISION ONE. THE DIVISION WAS RENAMED THE PREMIER DIVISION IN 2006, AND DESPITE FINISHING BOTTOM OF THE TABLE IN 06-07 THEY AVOIDED RELEGATION TO DIVISION ONE. HOWEVER, AFTER FINISHING SECOND-FROM-BOTTOM OF THE DIVISION IN 08-09, THE CLUB WERE RELEGATED TO DIVISION ONE. THEY WENT ON TO WIN DIVISION ONE THE FOLLOWING SEASON, EARNING AN IMMEDIATE PROMOTION BACK TO THE PREMIER DIVISION.

IN 2011 THE CLUB WERE RENAMED GE HAMBLE, FOLLOWING THE LATEST FACTORY TAKE-OVER, ALTHOUGH THE NEW NAME LASTED ONLY TWO SEASONS AS THEY REVERTED TO FOLLAND SPORTS IN 2013.

SINCE THE INTRODUCTION OF CO-CHAIRMEN IAN JOSEPHS AND JAMES LANGDOWN IN 2022/23 SEASON, THE CLUB HAS GROWN TO INCLUDE THE WESSEX LEAGUE FIRST TEAM, DEVELOPMENT SIDE, A TEAM, UIBS, UIG'S, UI3S, A SUNDAY FOLLAND FACTORY SIDE AND VETERANS TEAMS, ALL PLAYING AT THE FOLLAND PARK SITE, WITH THE MAIN STADIUM RENAMED THE ARROW ARENAIN THE 2023-24 SEASON.

THE VELOCITY WESSEX LEAGUE IS COMMITTED TO BEING A FAMILY FRIENDLY LEAGUE WHERE ALL OF THE COMMUNITY CAN ENJOY FOOTBALL. WE EXPECT ALL MEMBER CLUBS TO CREATE A POSITIVE ENVIRONMENT WHERE FANS, MEMBERS AND VISITORS CAN ATTEND A GAME, FREE FROM SWEARING AND UNACCEPTABLE LANGUAGE, FROM MANAGERS, PLAYERS, CLUB OFFICIALS AND SPECTATORS.

PLAYING IN SMALL GROUNDS MEANS THAT SWEARING AND UNACCEPTABLE LANGUAGE ON THE PITCH OR ANYWHERE IN THE GROUND CAN BE HEARD BY THOSE PRESENT. WORD OF THIS BEHAVIOUR WILL SOON SPREAD WITHIN THE COMMUNITY WHERE REPUTATIONS DEVELOP, AS TO THE TYPE OF CLUB YOU ARE. THIS WILL NOT ONLY

RESORT IN LACK OF COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT BUT CAN ALSO AFFECT FUNDING OPPORTUNITIES.

LOCAL BUSINESSES WILL NOT BE INTERESTED IN SUPPORTING A CLUB WITH BAD-MOUTHED MANAGERS, PLAYERS AND SUPPORTERS. FA RULES E3 AND E20 CAN ALSO MEAN FINES AND PENALTY POINTS BEING



ALL CLUBS, WHERE THE PROVISION OF ALCOHOL IS AVAILABLE, MUST HAVE A CURRENT AUTHORISING LICENCE, FROM THE REGULATORY BODY, AND PROVIDE THE LEAGUE WITH THE TERMS REGARDING THE MEMBERSHIP PROVISIONS. IRRESPECTIVE OF SUCH, IT IS A LEAGUE DIRECTIVE THAT NO ALCOHOL IS TO BE TAKEN OR CONSUMED, OUTSIDE OF THE LICENSED CLUBHOUSE AREA, IMMEDIATELY BEFORE, DURING AND IMMEDIATELY AFTER, ANY PLAYING PERIOD. FOR THE AVOIDANCE OF DOUBT AS TO THE AREAS OF THE GROUND COVERED BY THIS DIRECTIVE, EACH CLUB MUST HAVE AUTHORISATION, IN WRITING, BY THE LEAGUE OF THE SPECIFIC AREAS DEEMED TO BE PERMISSIBLE FOR THE CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOL.

FAILURE TO COMPLY, OR ANY BREACH OF THIS DIRECTIVE BY SPECTATORS, SUPPORTERS OR OFFICIALS, WILL BE DEALT WITH UNDER FA STANDARDISED RULE 4.2 AND 4.6 AS SEEN BELOW.

THIS DIRECTIVE IS CONSISTENT WITH THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE RELEVANT FA AND THEREFORE IS A BINDING OBLIGATION ON ALL WESSEX LEAGUE CLUBS.

FA STANDARDISED RULE 4.2

SAVE WHERE SPECIFICALLY PROVIDED OTHERWISE IN THE RULES, THE BOARD SHALL HAVE POWER TO APPLY, ACT UPON AND ENFORCE THE RULES AND SHALL HAVE JURISDICTION OVER ALL MATTERS AFFECTING THE LEAGUE INCLUDING ANY NOT PROVIDED FOR IN THESE RULES. THE BOARD SHALL ALSO HAVE THE POWER TO ISSUE AN ORDER OR INSTRUCTION, BY WAY OF A BOARD DIRECTIVE, IN THE BEST INTEREST OF THE LEAGUE, ON ANY MATTER NOT PROVIDED FOR IN THE RULES, WITH WHICH CLUBS MUST COMPLY OR BE SUBJECT TO SANCTION UNDER RULE 4.6, SAVE WHERE ANY SUCH DIRECTIVE IS INCONSISTENT WITH A RULE OR REGULATION OF THE FA, IN WHICH EVENT THE DIRECTIVE WILL NOT CREATE A BINDING OBLIGATION ON CLUBS

FA STANDARDISED 4.6.

IF A CLUB FAILS TO COMPLY WITH A BOARD DIRECTIVE WITHIN FOURTEEN DAYS OF NOTIFICATION OF SUCH ORDER OR INSTRUCTION, OR WITHIN FOURTEEN DAYS OF AN OPERATIVE DATE SPECIFIED IN THAT ORDER OR INSTRUCTION, IT SHALL NOT BE ALLOWED TO PLAY OR TAKE PART IN THE BUSINESS OF THE COMPANY UNTIL THE EXPIRY OF 7 DAYS FROM THE DAY THE ORDER OR INSTRUCTION IS COMPLIED WITH.
