ASH HISTORY

ASH UNITED FC WAS FOUNDED IN 1911 AND STARTED PLAYING MATCHES AT ASH COMMON.

THEY SOON BECAME WELL ESTABLISHED IN THE SURREY INTERMEDIATE LEAGUE, WINNING EVERY HONOUR POSSIBLE. AFTER THE SECOND WORLD WAR ASH UNITED RESTRUCTURED AND THE 1947/48 SEASON WAS THE MOST SUCCESSFUL IN THEIR SHORT HISTORY, WINNING THE LEAGUE CHAMPIONSHIP AND FOUR-CUP COMPETITIONS.

THEY THEN HAD TO WAIT UNTIL THE 1966/67
SEASON FOR THEIR NEXT SUCCESSFUL
CAMPAIGN WHERE THEY DOMINATED THE
SURREY INTERMEDIATE PREMIER "A"
LEAGUE. THE TITLE WAS WON WITH ONLY
TWO POINTS DROPPED OUT OF A POSSIBLE
FIFTY-TWO. THIS INCLUDED A LONG UNBEATEN
RECORD WITH 121 GOALS FOR AND ONLY 19 AGAINST

MORE RECENTLY

WE INTERGRATED WHAT WAS FORMERLY KNOWN AS JUNIOR SHOTS TO ASH UNITED YOUTH FC WITH OVER 300 CHILDREN FROM U5 TO U16 PLAYING ACCROSS THE SURREY YOUTH, HANTS & BERKS LEAGUES. WE HOPE THIS CEMENTS A PATHWAY FOR YOUNG PLAYERS TO PROGRESS INTO THE FIRST TEAM

THE RESERVE TEAM FOLLOWED SUIT WINNING THE DIVISION "A" TITLE SCORING 137 GOALS IN ONLY 26 GAMES. WITH THE CLUB HAVING A STRONG SQUAD OF PLAYERS, PROMOTION TO THE SURREY SENIOR LEAGUE WAS ACHIEVED IN 1968. FINISHING RUNNERS UP IN BOTH THE LEAGUE AND THE CUP IN THE FIRST SEASON THEIR FIRST SPELL IN THE SURREY SENIOR LEAGUE CAME TO AN END IN 1971 WHEN BEING FORCED TO CHANGE GROUNDS. ASH UNITED WERE RE-ADMITTED TO THE SURREY SENIOR LEAGUE WHEN A NEW PERMANENT GROUND WAS FOUND, WHICH HAPPENS TO BE THE CURRENT GROUND AT YOUNGS DRIVE. THE SMURFIT KAPPA STADIUM THE NEXT SUCCESSFUL SEASON WAS 1977/78. THEY WON THE CHARITY CUP BEATING DORKING 2-1. THE FOLLOWING SEASON THEY WERE RUNNERS-UP IN BOTH THE NEWLY NAMED COMBINED COUNTIES LEAGUE AND THE PHILIPS FOOTBALL FLOODLIGHTING CUP COMPETITION.

THE APPOINTMENT OF OUR NEW FIRST TEAM MANAGER - OUR RESERVES & U18S ARE RUN BY THE COACHING TEAM (ALEX JUSTIN JOSH & PAUL) MOVE TO THE ALDERSHOT AND DISTRICT LEAGUE - OUR U18 PLAYING IN THE ALLIED COUNTIES U18 MIDWEEK LEAGUE - OUR NEWLY FORMED ASH UNITED WOMEN (MANAGED BY DAN & BLAINE) PLAY IN THE WOMENS SOUTHERN COMBINATION LEAGUE AND WE ALSO HAVE A NEW VETS TEAM RUN

NEWPORT WAS FORMED IN JANUARY 1888. LIKE MANY OTHERS AROUND IN THESE TIMES IT IS INAUGURATED FROM A PUBLIC MEETING, THIS ONE BEING HELD AT THE WARBURTON HOTEL. ONCE MORE, A VOTE WAS TAKEN WHETHER TO PLAY RUGBY OR SOCCER. THE EARLIEST RECORDED GAME WAS ON 7TH MARCH WHEN THE TEAM WAS DEFEATED 2-1 BY LUGLEY HOUSE SCHOOL. THE FIRST GROUND WAS 'WELLS FIELD' WHICH BECAME KNOWN AS CHURCH LITTEN, THEIR HOME FOR 100 YEARS. IN 1911 THE CLUB MERGED WITH ANOTHER SIDE TO BECOME NEWPORT UNITED, BUT THAT TITLE LASTED FOR JUST THE 1911/12 SEASON, WHEN THE CLUB WERE BEATEN FINALISTS IN THE HAMPSHIRE JUNIOR CUP. PORT WERE ONE OF THE WESSEX LEAGUE'S FOUNDERS AND ARE CURRENT MEMBERS HAVING RE-JOINED IN 2008.

THE MODERN NEWPORT IOW FOOTBALL CLUB, WITH ITS WELL-APPOINTED ST GEORGE'S PARK FACILITIES, (WHICH THE CLUB OFFICIALLY VACATED AT THE END OF THE 2018/19 SEASON), PRESENTED A DIFFERENT PICTURE FROM THAT CONJURED UP BY THE CLUB'S ORIGINS ON JANUARY 27TH 1888.

THE ACTUAL DATE OF FORMATION CAN BE ESTABLISHED FROM THE ORIGINAL MINUTE BOOK, WHICH IS STILL IN THE CLUB'S POSSESSION. AT THAT TIME, OVER 130 YEARS AGO, NEWPORT PLAYED ON A PIECE OF LAND KNOWN AS WELL'S FIELD, WHICH LATER BECAME KNOWN AS CHURCH LITTEN. THOSE EARLY DAYS MEANT A WALK FROM THE LOCAL PUBLIC HOUSE, WHERE THE PLAYERS CHANGED, TO A FIELD, IN ORDER TO CLEAR THE COWS BEFORE PLAY COULD COMMENCE. NEWPORT BECAME FOUNDER MEMBERS OF THE ISLE OF WIGHT LEAGUE IN 1898 AND WERE LEAGUE CHAMPIONS ON FOUR OCCASIONS.

IN 1927 THE CLUB BECAME MEMBERS OF THE HAMPSHIRE LEAGUE, TAKING OVER THE FIXTURES OF THE DEFUNCT GOSPORT ALBION CLUB IN MID-SEASON AND WITHIN THREE SEASONS NEWPORT HAD WON THE COUNTY LEAGUE CHAMPIONSHIP FOR THE FIRST TIME. THE 1930'S SAW FURTHER WINS IN THE HAMPSHIRE LEAGUE AND ALSO THE HAMPSHIRE SENIOR CUP BEING WON IN 1932. THE 1935/36 SEASON SAW NEWPORT REACH THE 2ND ROUND OF THE FA CUP FOR THE FIRST TIME, BOWING OUT AT SOUTHALL.

IN THE 1960'S WE HAD FURTHER HAMPSHIRE SENIOR CUP WINS IN 1961 AND 1966 AND IN THE 1970S A HAT TRICK OF HAMPSHIRE LEAGUE TITLES IN 1979, 1969 AND 1981 AND TWO HAMPSHIRE SENIOR CUP SUCCESSES IN 1980 AND 1981

IN 1986, NEWPORT BECAME FOUNDER MEMBERS OF THE WESSEX LEAGUE, FINISHING A CREDITABLE FOURTH PLACE IN THAT DEBUT SEASON. IN THE 1989/90 SEASON NEWPORT WERE PROMOTED TO THE SOUTHERN LEAGUE. THE 2000/01 SEASON SAW US WIN THE DR MARTENS LEAGUE EASTERN DIVISION CHAMPIONSHIP. HOWEVER WE FOUND THE TOP FLIGHT TOO MUCH AND RETURNED THE EASTERN DIVISION AFTER JUST ONE SEASON.

SOON AFTER IN THE 2003/04 SEASON THE CLUB WAS IN ADMINISTRATION AND THE FIGHT TO KEEP THE CLUB ALIVE WAS TAKEN UP BY THE SUPPORTERS, WITH THE SAVE NEWPORT (FC) ACTION GROUP SAVING THE CLUB. 2004/05 SAW NEWPORT MAKE ITS DEBUT IN THE ISTHMIAN LEAGUE.

THE 2006/07 SEASON SAW A RETURN TO THE MORE FAMILIAR SOUTHERN LEAGUE, PLAYING IN THE SOUTH AND WEST DIVISION. ON IST AUGUST 2007 THE PORT PLAYED A FRIENDLY AGAINST A FULL STRENGTH PORTSMOUTH TEAM WHICH DREW 3112 SUPPORTERS TO ST GEORGE'S PARK, THE HIGHEST CROWD EVER TO WATCH A MATCH AT THE GROUND. THE CLUB WAS RELEGATED BACK TO THE WESSEX LEAGUE AT THE END OF THE 2007/08 SEASON AFTER FINISHING BOTTOM OF DIVISION ONE SOUTH AND WEST OF THE SOUTHERN LEAGUE. THE CLUB THEN REMAINED IN THE WESSEX LEAGUE PREMIER DIVISION BUT WENT ON TO WIN THE RUSSELL COTES CUP IN 2010/11.

ANDY SAMPSON TOOK OVER AT THE START OF THE 2015-16 SEASON WITH THE CLUB FINISHING 7TH IN THE WESSEX PREMIER, FOLLOWED BY 10TH AND 15TH IN THE TWO FOLLOWING SEASONS. AT THE END OF THE 2017/18 SEASON THE CLUB WAS RELEGATED TO WESSEX DIVISION ONE. SOON AFTER THE START OF THE 2020/21 SEASON ANDY STEPPED DOWN, WITH STEWART SHEPHERD AND STEVE BROUGHAM TAKING THE REINS AS JOINT MANAGERS.

IN RECENT SEASONS THE CLUB HAD BEEN UNDER PRESSURE TO LEAVE ST GEORGE'S PARK AND ALTHOUGH RECEIVING AN EVICTION ORDER IN 2016 WAS GIVEN A REPRIEVE AT THE LAST MINUTE. THE PORT ARE HOPEFUL OF MOVING TO A NEW STADIUM IN TIME FOR THE START OF THE 2021/22 SEASON, BUT IN THE INTERIM WILL BE PLAYING ON A GROUND-SHARE BASIS AT BEATRICE AVENUE, THE HOME OF EAST COWES VICTORIA, FOR WHICH WE THANK OUR FRIENDS AT VICS. AFTER 30 YEARS, 2018/19 WAS THE LAST SEASON AT ST. GEORGE'S PARK AS WE NOW PLAN FOR THE FUTURE AT THE PLANNED NEW GROUND: WIGHTFIBRE PARK, AT THE RACECOURSE ON THE OUTSKIRTS OF NEWPORT ON THE WOOTTON BRIDGE ROAD.



ALL CLUBS, WHERE THE PROVISION OF ALCOHOL IS AVAILABLE, MUST HAVE A CURRENT AUTHORISING LICENCE, FROM THE REGULATORY BODY, AND PROVIDE THE LEAGUE WITH THE TERMS REGARDING THE MEMBERSHIP PROVISIONS.

IRRESPECTIVE OF SUCH, IT IS A LEAGUE DIRECTIVE THAT NO ALCOHOL IS TO BE

TRRESPECTIVE OF SUCH, IT IS A LEAGUE DIRECTIVE THAT NO ALCOHOL IS TO BE TAKEN OR CONSUMED, OUTSIDE OF THE LICENSED CLUBHOUSE AREA, IMMEDIATELY BEFORE, DURING AND IMMEDIATELY AFTER, ANY PLAYING PERIOD.

FOR THE AVOIDANCE OF DOUBT AS TO THE AREAS OF THE GROUND COVERED BY THIS DIRECTIVE. EACH CLUB MUST HAVE AUTHORISATION, IN WRITING, BY THE LEAGUE OF THE SPECIFIC AREAS DEEMED TO BE PERMISSIBLE FOR THE CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOL.

FAILURE TO COMPLY, OR ANY BREACH OF THIS DIRECTIVE BY SPECTATORS, SUPPORTERS OR OFFICIALS, WILL BE DEALT WITH UNDER FA STANDARDISED RULE 4.2 AND 4.6 AS SEEN BELOW.

THIS DIRECTIVE IS CONSISTENT WITH THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE RELEVANT FA AND THEREFORE IS A BINDING OBLIGATION ON ALL WESSEX LEAGUE CLUBS:

FA STANDARDISED RULE 4.2

SAVE WHERE SPECIFICALLY PROVIDED OTHERWISE IN THE RULES, THE BOARD SHALL HAVE POWER TO APPLY, ACT UPON AND ENFORCE THE RULES AND SHALL HAVE JURISDICTION OVER ALL MATTERS AFFECTING THE LEAGUE INCLUDING ANY NOT PROVIDED FOR IN THESE RULES. THE BOARD SHALL ALSO HAVE THE POWER TO ISSUE AN ORDER OR INSTRUCTION, BY WAY OF A BOARD DIRECTIVE, IN THE BEST INTEREST OF THE LEAGUE, ON ANY MATTER NOT PROVIDED FOR IN THE RULES, WITH WHICH CLUBS MUST COMPLY OR BE SUBJECT TO SANCTION UNDER RULE 4.6, SAVE WHERE ANY SUCH DIRECTIVE IS INCONSISTENT WITH A RULE OR REGULATION OF THE FA, IN WHICH EVENT THE DIRECTIVE WILL NOT CREATE A BINDING OBLIGATION ON CLUBS

FA STANDARDISED 4.6.

IF A CLUB FAILS TO COMPLY WITH A BOARD DIRECTIVE WITHIN FOURTEEN DAYS OF NOTIFICATION OF SUCH ORDER OR INSTRUCTION, OR WITHIN FOURTEEN DAYS OF AN OPERATIVE DATE SPECIFIED IN THAT ORDER OR INSTRUCTION, IT SHALL NOT BE ALLOWED TO PLAY OR TAKE PART IN THE BUSINESS OF THE COMPANY UNTIL THE EXPIRY OF 7 DAYS FROM THE DAY THE ORDER OR INSTRUCTION IS COMPLIED WITH.


