ASH UNITED FC WAS FOUNDED IN 1911 AND STARTED PLAYING MATCHES AT ASH COMMON.

THEY SOON BECAME WELL ESTABLISHED IN THE SURREY INTERMEDIATE LEAGUE, WINNING EVERY HONOUR POSSIBLE. AFTER THE SECOND WORLD WAR ASH UNITED RESTRUCTURED AND THE 1947/48 SEASON WAS THE MOST SUCCESSFUL IN THEIR SHORT HISTORY, WINNING THE LEAGUE CHAMPIONSHIP AND FOUR-CUP COMPETITIONS.

THEY THEN HAD TO WAIT UNTIL THE 1966/67 SEASON FOR THEIR NEXT SUCCESSFUL CAMPAIGN WHERE THEY DOMINATED THE SURREY INTERMEDIATE PREMIER "A" LEAGUE. THE TITLE WAS WON WITH ONLY TWO POINTS DROPPED OUT OF A POSSIBLE FIFTY-TWO. THIS INCLUDED A LONG UNBEATEN RECORD WITH 121 GOALS FOR AND ONLY 19 AGAINST

MORE RECENTLY

WE INTERGRATED WHAT WAS FORMERLY KNOWN AS JUNIOR SHOTS TO ASH UNITED YOUTH FC WITH OVER 300 CHILDREN FROM U5 TO U16 PLAYING ACCROSS THE SURREY YOUTH, HANTS & BERKS LEAGUES. WE HOPE THIS CEMENTS A PATHWAY FOR YOUNG PLAYERS TO PROGRESS INTO THE FIRST TEAM

THE RESERVE TEAM FOLLOWED SUIT WINNING THE DIVISION "A" TITLE SCORING 137 GOALS IN ONLY 26 GAMES. WITH THE CLUB HAVING A STRONG SQUAD OF PLAYERS, PROMOTION TO THE SURREY SENIOR LEAGUE WAS ACHIEVED IN 1968. FINISHING RUNNERS UP IN BOTH THE LEAGUE AND THE CUP IN THE FIRST SEASON THEIR FIRST SPELL IN THE SURREY SENIOR LEAGUE CAME TO AN END IN 1971 WHEN BEING FORCED TO CHANGE GROUNDS. ASH UNITED WERE RE-ADMITTED TO THE SURREY SENIOR LEAGUE WHEN A NEW PERMANENT GROUND WAS FOUND, WHICH HAPPENS TO BE THE CURRENT GROUND AT YOUNGS DRIVE. THE SMURFIT KAPPA STADIUM THE NEXT SUCCESSFUL SEASON WAS 1977/78. THEY WON THE CHARITY CUP BEATING DORKING 2-1. THE FOLLOWING SEASON THEY WERE RUNNERS-UP IN BOTH THE NEWLY NAMED COMBINED COUNTIES LEAGUE AND THE PHILIPS FOOTBALL FLOODLIGHTING CUP COMPETITION.

THE APPOINTMENT OF OUR NEW FIRST TEAM MANAGER - OUR RESERVES & UIBS ARE RUN BY THE COACHING TEAM (ALEX JUSTIN JOSH & PAUL) MOVE TO THE ALDERSHOT AND DISTRICT LEAGUE - OUR UIB PLAYING IN THE ALLIED COUNTIES UIB MIDWEEK LEAGUE - OUR NEWLY FORMED ASH UNITED WOMEN (MANAGED BY DAN & BLAINE) PLAY IN THE WOMENS SOUTHERN COMBINATION LEAGUE AND WE ALSO HAVE A NEW VETS TEAM RUN







THE CLUB WAS ESTABLISHED IN 1998 UNDER THE NAME LYMINGTON & NEW MILTON AS A MERGER OF AFC LYMINGTON FROM THE WESSEX LEAGUE AND NEW MILTON TOWN FROM DIVISION TWO OF THE HAMPSHIRE LEAGUE, WITH THE NEW CLUB PLAYING AT NEW MILTON TOWN'S FAWCETTS FIELD GROUND. THE AMALGAMATION OF THE TWO CLUBS ALSO LED TO THE FORMATION OF LYMINGTON TOWN, WHO ENTERED DIVISION THREE OF THE HAMPSHIRE LEAGUE, AND A NEW, NEW MILTON CLUB BASED IN MILFORD-ON-SEA, WHO JOINED DIVISION TWO FOR A SINGLE SEASON BEFORE FOLDING. IN THEIR FIRST SEASON, LYMINGTON & NEW MILTON RETAINED THE WESSEX LEAGUE TITLE WON BY AFC LYMINGTON IN 1997/98. HOWEVER, THEY WERE UNABLE TO TAKE PROMOTION AS THEIR GROUND FAILED TO MEET THE REQUIREMENTS. THEY WERE RUNNERS-UP IN THE LEAGUE IN EACH OF THE NEXT TWO SEASONS, MAKING ANOTHER FAILED APPLICATION FOR PROMOTION IN 1999/20.

IN 2003/04 LYMINGTON & NEW MILTON WERE WESSEX LEAGUE CHAMPIONS, EARNING PROMOTION TO DIVISION ONE OF THE ISTHMIAN LEAGUE. HOWEVER, AFTER A SINGLE SEASON IN THE ISTHMIAN LEAGUE, THEY WERE TRANSFERRED TO DIVISION ONE SOUTH & WEST OF THE SOUTHERN LEAGUE. DESPITE FINISHING ABOVE THE RELEGATION ZONE IN 2006/07, THE CLUB RESIGNED FROM THE LEAGUE AT THE END OF THE SEASON AFTER MOST OF THE CLUB'S OFFICIALS RESIGNED. DROPPING BACK INTO THE PREMIER DIVISION OF THE WESSEX LEAGUE, THE CLUB WERE RENAMED NEW MILTON TOWN. IN 2012/13 THEY FINISHED BOTTOM OF THE PREMIER DIVISION AND WERE RELEGATED TO DIVISION ONE AFTER RESCINDING THEIR RESIGNATION FROM THE LEAGUE WHEN A PROPOSED MERGER WITH BASHLEY FELL THROUGH. THE FOLLOWING FOUR SEASONS SAW NEW MILTON TOWN STRUGGLE TO ENTER THE TOP HALF OF THE TABLE.

LOU FERN TOOK OVER AS CHAIRMAN AT THE BEGINNING OF THE 2018/19 SEASON AND SET OUT TO GET THE CLUB RUNNING IN A MORE PROFESSIONAL MANNER. WHILST THINGS IMPROVED OFF THE PITCH THE RESULTS DID NOT IMPROVE ON AND THE FOLLOWING YEARS SAW NUMEROUS MANAGERS TAKE THE HOT SEAT.

LOU FERN BECAME CHAIRMAN AT THE START OF THE 2018/19 SEASON AND AIMED TO IMPROVE THE CLUB'S PROFESSIONALISM. WHILE OFF-PITCH MATTERS IMPROVED, ON-PITCH RESULTS DID NOT, LEADING TO FREQUENT CHANGES IN MANAGEMENT, BUT NO ONE MAKING A REAL IMPROVEMENT UNTIL THE APPOINTMENT OF PAUL TURNER FROM POOLE TOWN FC. WITH A WHOLE NEW MANAGEMENT TEAM AND PLAYING SQUAD, THE 2020/21 SEASON, DESPITE BEING A STOP START ONE FOR ALL TEAMS WITH THE COVID PANDEMIC BRINGING A HALT TO THE SEASON EARLY, NEW MILTON TOWN HAD THEIR BEST RUN IN THE FA VASE IN YEARS, REACHING THE 3RD ROUND, FINALLY BEING KNOCKED OUT BY CLEVEDON TOWN 2-0, WHO PLAY A STEP HIGHER.

WITH 2021/22 BACK TO NORMAL, THE LINNETS HAD A CRACKING SEASON WITH A 9TH PLACE FINISH IN THE LEAGUE & A RUN TO THE 4TH ROUND IN THE FA VASE, LOSING TO BROCKENHURST, FROM THE LEAGUE ABOVE, IN FRONT OF 952 PEOPLE.

THE 2022/23 SEASON BROUGHT A NEW STADIUM SPONSOR, DMW GLAZING, INTO THE LINNET'S FAMILY AND NEW MILTON TOWN HAD ANOTHER STRONG CAMPAIGN, NARROWLY MISSING OUT ON PROMOTION. FINISHING 3RD IN THE LEAGUE, THEY THEN LOST 2-4 ON PENALTIES IN THE PLAY OFFS AT HOME AGAINST PETERSFIELD TOWN, WITH 544 SPECTATORS IN ATTENDANCE.

THE 2023/24 SEASON SAW SIGNIFICANT CHALLENGES FOR THE CLUB. PAUL TURNER AND HIS MANAGEMENT TEAM RESIGNED, AND NEW MILTON TOWN STRUGGLED TO FIND A SUITABLE REPLACEMENT, MANAGING ONLY 3 POINTS IN 20 GAMES. THIS LED TO A MID-SEASON CHANGE IN MANAGEMENT, AS WELL AS JOHN BREAKER BEING DRAFTED IN AS EMERGENCY CHAIRMAN FOLLOWING LOU FERN'S DEPARTURE. THE SEASON ENDED IN STARK CONTRAST TO THE PREVIOUS ONE, WITH NEW MILTON TOWN FINISHING 3RD FROM BOTTOM, JUST NARROWLY AVOIDING RELEGATION. LOOKING AHEAD, NEW MILTON TOWN ANTICIPATES A FRESH START FOR THE 2024/25 SEASON UNDER THE NEW CHAIRMAN DAN WILLS, FROM DMW GLAZING, AND A NEW MANAGEMENT TEAM LED BY MATT MAYBURY. SIGNIFICANT IMPROVEMENTS ARE BEING MADE BEHIND THE SCENES, WITH HOPES FOR A FANTASTIC SEASON AHEAD. THE FUTURE LOOKS BRIGHT.

CHAIRMEN, CLUB OFFICIALS, PLAYERS AND FANS ALL HAVE A ROLE TO PLAY IN ENSURING THAT WE TACKLE THE PROBLEM OF USING UNACCEPTABLE LANGUAGE, WHICH IS UNLAWFUL IN A PUBLIC PLACE.

CLEANING UP YOUR CLUB, INVOLVES EVERYONE, FROM THE CHAIRMAN, SECRETARY, MANAGER, PLAYERS AND SUPPORTERS, WORKING TO MAKE YOUR CLUB MORE ATTRACTIVE TO FAMILIES AND YOUNGER FANS. ENSURING STRONGER AND LASTING TIES WITH YOUR LOCAL COMMUNITY AND ENCOURAGING A BIGGER FAN BASE:

A SWEAR-FREE CLUB WILL LEAD TO, A MORE FAVOURABLE PLACE FOR ALL, INCREASED OPPORTUNITY TO ATTRACT LOCAL BUSINESS, INCREASED OPPORTUNITY TO ATTRACT SPONSORS AND BETTER LOCAL FUNDING OPPORTUNITIES, AND A POSITIVE INCLUSIVE COMMUNITY IMAGE.



ALL CLUBS, WHERE THE PROVISION OF ALCOHOL IS AVAILABLE, MUST HAVE A CURRENT AUTHORISING LICENCE, FROM THE REGULATORY BODY, AND PROVIDE THE LEAGUE WITH THE TERMS REGARDING THE MEMBERSHIP PROVISIONS. IRRESPECTIVE OF SUCH, IT IS A LEAGUE DIRECTIVE THAT NO ALCOHOL IS TO BE TAKEN OR CONSUMED, OUTSIDE OF THE LICENSED CLUBHOUSE AREA, IMMEDIATELY BEFORE, DURING AND IMMEDIATELY AFTER, ANY PLAYING PERIOD. FOR THE AVOIDANCE OF DOUBT AS TO THE AREAS OF THE GROUND COVERED BY THIS DIRECTIVE, EACH CLUB MUST HAVE AUTHORISATION, IN WRITING, BY THE LEAGUE OF THE SPECIFIC AREAS DEEMED TO BE PERMISSIBLE FOR THE CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOL.

FAILURE TO COMPLY, OR ANY BREACH OF THIS DIRECTIVE BY SPECTATORS, SUPPORTERS OR OFFICIALS, WILL BE DEALT WITH UNDER FA STANDARDISED RULE 4.2 AND 4.6 AS SEEN BELOW.

THIS DIRECTIVE IS CONSISTENT WITH THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE RELEVANT FA AND THEREFORE IS A BINDING OBLIGATION ON ALL WESSEX LEAGUE CLUBS.

FA STANDARDISED RULE 4.2

SAVE WHERE SPECIFICALLY PROVIDED OTHERWISE IN THE RULES, THE BOARD SHALL HAVE POWER TO APPLY, ACT UPON AND ENFORCE THE RULES AND SHALL HAVE JURISDICTION OVER ALL MATTERS AFFECTING THE LEAGUE INCLUDING ANY NOT PROVIDED FOR IN THESE RULES. THE BOARD SHALL ALSO HAVE THE POWER TO ISSUE AN ORDER OR INSTRUCTION, BY WAY OF A BOARD DIRECTIVE, IN THE BEST INTEREST OF THE LEAGUE, ON ANY MATTER NOT PROVIDED FOR IN THE RULES, WITH WHICH CLUBS MUST COMPLY OR BE SUBJECT TO SANCTION UNDER RULE 4.6, SAVE WHERE ANY SUCH DIRECTIVE IS INCONSISTENT WITH A RULE OR REGULATION OF THE FA, IN WHICH EVENT THE DIRECTIVE WILL NOT CREATE A BINDING OBLIGATION ON CLUBS

FA STANDARDISED 4.6.

IF A CLUB FAILS TO COMPLY WITH A BOARD DIRECTIVE WITHIN FOURTEEN DAYS OF NOTIFICATION OF SUCH ORDER OR INSTRUCTION, OR WITHIN FOURTEEN DAYS OF AN OPERATIVE DATE SPECIFIED IN THAT ORDER OR INSTRUCTION, IT SHALL NOT BE ALLOWED TO PLAY OR TAKE PART IN THE BUSINESS OF THE COMPANY UNTIL THE EXPIRY OF 7 DAYS FROM THE DAY THE ORDER OR INSTRUCTION IS COMPLIED WITH.

COUNTY FA OR THE FA: BE REQUIRED TO APOLOGISE TO TEAM-MATES. THE OPPOSITION. MATCH OFFICIAL OR MANAGER/COACH RECEIVE A WARNING FROM THE MANAGER/COACH RECEIVE A WRITTEN WARNING FROM THE CLUB COMMITTEE BE REQUIRED TO ATTEND AN FA EDUCATION COURSE BE DROPPED OR SUBSTITUTED BE SUSPENDED FROM TRAINING NOT SELECTED FOR THE TEAM BE REQUIRED TO SERVE A SUSPENSION BE FINED BE REQUIRED TO LEAVE THE CLUB IN ADDITION: THE FA/COUNTY FA COULD IMPOSE A FINE AND OR SUSPENSION ON THE CLUB.
