## ASH HISTORY

ASH UNITED FC WAS FOUNDED IN 1911 AND STARTED PLAYING MATCHES AT ASH COMMON.

THEY SOON BECAME WELL ESTABLISHED IN THE SURREY INTERMEDIATE LEAGUE, WINNING EVERY HONOUR POSSIBLE.
AFTER THE SECOND WORLD WAR ASH UNITED RESTRUCTURED AND THE 1947/48 SEASON WAS THE MOST SUCCESSFUL IN THEIR SHORT HISTORY, WINNING THE LEAGUE CHAMPIONSHIP AND FOUR-CUP COMPETITIONS.

THEY THEN HAD TO WAIT UNTIL THE 1966/67
SEASON FOR THEIR NEXT SUCCESSFUL
CAMPAIGN WHERE THEY DOMINATED THE
SURREY INTERMEDIATE PREMIER "A"
LEAGUE. THE TITLE WAS WON WITH ONLY
TWO POINTS DROPPED OUT OF A POSSIBLE
FIFTY-TWO. THIS INCLUDED A LONG UNBEATEN
RECORD WITH 121 GOALS FOR AND ONLY 19 AGAINST

WE INTERGRATED WHAT WAS FORMERLY KNOWN AS JUNIOR SHOTS TO ASH UNITED YOUTH FC WITH OVER 300 CHILDREN FROM U5 TO U16 PLAYING ACCROSS THE SURREY YOUTH, HANTS & BERKS LEAGUES. WE HOPE THIS CEMENTS A PATHWAY FOR YOUNG PLAYERS TO PROGRESS INTO THE FIRST TEAM

THE RESERVE TEAM FOLLOWED SUIT WINNING THE DIVISION "A" TITLE SCORING 137 GOALS IN ONLY 26 GAMES. WITH THE CLUB HAVING A STRONG SQUAD OF PLAYERS, PROMOTION TO THE SURREY SENIOR LEAGUE WAS ACHIEVED IN 1968. FINISHING RUNNERS UP IN BOTH THE LEAGUE AND THE CUP IN THE FIRST SEASON THEIR FIRST SPELL IN THE SURREY SENIOR LEAGUE CAME TO AN END IN 1971 WHEN BEING FORCED TO CHANGE GROUNDS. ASH UNITED WERE RE-ADMITTED TO THE SURREY SENIOR LEAGUE WHEN A NEW PERMANENT GROUND WAS FOUND. WHICH HAPPENS TO BE THE CURRENT GROUND AT YOUNGS DRIVE. THE SMURFIT KAPPA STADIUM THE NEXT SUCCESSFUL SEASON WAS 1977/78. THEY WON THE CHARITY CUP BEATING DORKING 2-1. THE FOLLOWING SEASON THEY WERE RUNNERS-UP IN BOTH THE NEWLY NAMED COMBINED COUNTIES LEAGUE AND THE PHILIPS FOOTBALL FLOODLIGHTING CUP COMPETITION.

THE APPOINTMENT OF OUR NEW FIRST TEAM MANAGER - OUR RESERVES & U18S ARE RUN BY THE COACHING TEAM (ALEX JUSTIN JOSH & PAUL) MOVE TO THE ALDERSHOT AND DISTRICT LEAGUE - OUR U18 PLAYING IN THE ALLIED COUNTIES U18 MIDWEEK LEAGUE - OUR NEWLY FORMED ASH UNITED WOMEN (MANAGED BY DAN & BLAINE) PLAY IN THE WOMENS SOUTHERN COMBINATION LEAGUE AND WE ALSO HAVE A NEW VETS TEAM RUN





Our club was founded as AWRE Football Club in 1952 by Charles Green, Ted Hall, Gordon Carter, and Don Sharp, and were nicknamed "The Atom Men" after the newly founded Atomic Weapons Research Establishment. As the AWRE complex was still under construction when the club was established, the players used empty contractors' huts as changing rooms – carrying the tin bath into whichever building was designated for that day's football. The players were also responsible for the pitch, and would mow and mark out the pitch before the match started. The club received support from Sir William Penney during his work at AWRE on the Operation Hurricane project.

In the late 1960s/early 1970s, we changed our name, to AFC Aldermaston. In 1979 we were promoted from the Reading & District League into Division One of the Hellenic League, where we spent the next seven seasons. From 1986 until 1991 we played in local football leagues, including the North Hampshire League, before joining Division Three of the Hampshire League in 1991. We finished fifth in the first season, earning promotion to Division Two. However, we were soon relegated back to Division Three the following

season, where we remained until 1999. When the Hampshire League was re-organised prior to the 1999–2000 season, we were placed in the Premier Division.

When the Hampshire and Wessex Leagues merged in 2004, we became members of Division Two of the Wessex League. At the end of the 2004-05 season we suffered relegation. The division was renamed Division Two in 2006, and was disbanded at the end of the 2006-07 season, and as a result we moved up back up to Division One. 2009-10 season, was our worst season and during a very difficult time we lost 40 consecutive games, which broke the previous record of 39 straight losses held jointly by Stockport United and Poole Town. The 40th defeat came on 8 April 2010, a 2-0 loss to Downton. This was undoubtedly the worst time for the club in living memory, and it took a great effort to keep going at this time. The losing streak thankfully came to an end on 10 April 2010, when we club drew 1-1 against Warminster Town, and then finally winning the next match against Petersfield Town 2-1 win for Aldermaston, to provide a much needed boost for all of us at that difficult time. Unsurprisingly, we finished bottom of Division One with just the one win in 40 matches, and were relegated to the Hampshire Premier League, where played for four seasons before moving to the Thames Valley Premier League for season 2014-15, when we reached the final of the Berks & Bucks Intermediate Cup, which we narrowly lost 2-1 to Hale Leys Utd, the final of the Reading Senior Cup played at the Madjeski which we lost 1-0 to champions Marlow Utd, and the final of the Basingstoke Senior Cup where we lost to our local rivals Tadley Calleva 2-1 AET. 2015-16 season we finished seventh in the TVPL Premier Division, and again reaching the final of the Reading Senior Cup only to be beaten in a fourth final 1-0 to Cookham Dean. We made a welcome return to Step 6 football as we were promoted to Division One East of the Hellenic League, 2016-17 saw us finish 7th in the Hellenic League this matched our highest ever finish at Step 6 football. 2017-18 season saw us finish 11th in the Hellenic League. 2018-19 season saw us finish 3rd in the Hellenic League this beat 2016-17 seasons highest ever finish. This was well deserved by everyone connected to the club. Also getting to the Reading Challenge Cup Final at the Madjeski Stadium which saw us lose 5-0 to Hellenic Premier League Winners Wantage Town and collecting the runners up medals. In the 2018-19 season we finished 3rd in the Hellenic Division One East, the 2019-20 and 2020-21 season were started and halted due to the pandemic. The start of the 2021-22 season saw another lateral move from the Hellenic League into the Combined Counties league. Our first season in the Combined Counties saw us finish 14th and the 2022-23 season this was a disappointing season in our league campaign where we finished 19th, one of the highlights was making it to the Division One League Cup Final which was held at Windsor FC's ground. In the final we were narrowly beaten 3-1 to Penn & Tylers Green. The start of the 2023-24 season has seen another lateral movement from the Combined Counties rejoining the Wessex League, we look forward to visiting some familiar grounds and meeting all the clubs again. The close season has seen a change in management welcoming Marcus Richardson and his backroom team to the club

IRRESPECTIVE OF SUCH, IT IS A LEAGUE DIRECTIVE THAT NO ALCOHOL IS TO BE TAKEN OR CONSUMED, OUTSIDE OF THE LICENSED CLUBHOUSE AREA, IMMEDIATELY BEFORE, DURING AND IMMEDIATELY AFTER, ANY PLAYING PERIOD.

FOR THE AVOIDANCE OF DOUBT AS TO THE AREAS OF THE GROUND COVERED BY THIS DIRECTIVE, EACH CLUB MUST HAVE AUTHORISATION, IN WRITING, BY THE LEAGUE OF THE SPECIFIC AREAS DEEMED TO BE PERMISSIBLE FOR THE CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOL.

FAILURE TO COMPLY, OR ANY BREACH OF THIS DIRECTIVE BY SPECTATORS, SUPPORTERS OR OFFICIALS, WILL BE DEALT WITH UNDER FA STANDARDISED RULE 4.2 AND 4.6 AS SEEN BELOW.

THIS DIRECTIVE IS CONSISTENT WITH THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE RELEVANT FA AND THEREFORE IS A BINDING OBLIGATION ON ALL WESSEX LEAGUE CLUBS:

FA STANDARDISED RULE 4.2

SAVE WHERE SPECIFICALLY PROVIDED OTHERWISE IN THE RULES, THE BOARD SHALL HAVE POWER TO APPLY, ACT UPON AND ENFORCE THE RULES AND SHALL HAVE JURISDICTION OVER ALL MATTERS AFFECTING THE LEAGUE INCLUDING ANY NOT PROVIDED FOR IN THESE RULES. THE BOARD SHALL ALSO HAVE THE POWER TO ISSUE AN ORDER OR INSTRUCTION, BY WAY OF A BOARD DIRECTIVE, IN THE BEST INTEREST OF THE LEAGUE, ON ANY MATTER NOT PROVIDED FOR IN THE RULES, WITH WHICH CLUBS MUST COMPLY OR BE SUBJECT TO SANCTION UNDER RULE 4.6, SAVE WHERE ANY SUCH DIRECTIVE IS INCONSISTENT WITH A RULE OR REGULATION OF THE FA, IN WHICH EVENT THE DIRECTIVE WILL NOT CREATE A BINDING OBLIGATION ON CLUBS

FA STANDARDISED 4.6.

IF A CLUB FAILS TO COMPLY WITH A BOARD DIRECTIVE WITHIN FOURTEEN DAYS OF NOTIFICATION OF SUCH ORDER OR INSTRUCTION, OR WITHIN FOURTEEN DAYS OF AN OPERATIVE DATE SPECIFIED IN THAT ORDER OR INSTRUCTION, IT SHALL NOT BE ALLOWED TO PLAY OR TAKE PART IN THE BUSINESS OF THE COMPANY UNTIL THE EXPIRY OF 7 DAYS FROM THE DAY THE ORDER OR INSTRUCTION IS COMPLIED WITH.


