ASH HISTORY

ASH UNITED FC WAS FOUNDED IN 1911 AND STARTED PLAYING MATCHES AT ASH COMMON.

THEY SOON BECAME WELL ESTABLISHED IN THE SURREY INTERMEDIATE LEAGUE, WINNING EVERY HONOUR POSSIBLE.
AFTER THE SECOND WORLD WAR ASH UNITED RESTRUCTURED AND THE 1947/48 SEASON WAS THE MOST SUCCESSFUL IN THEIR SHORT HISTORY, WINNING THE LEAGUE CHAMPIONSHIP AND FOUR-CUP COMPETITIONS.

THEY THEN HAD TO WAIT UNTIL THE 1966/67
SEASON FOR THEIR NEXT SUCCESSFUL
CAMPAIGN WHERE THEY DOMINATED THE
SURREY INTERMEDIATE PREMIER "A"
LEAGUE. THE TITLE WAS WON WITH ONLY
TWO POINTS DROPPED OUT OF A POSSIBLE
FIFTY-TWO. THIS INCLUDED A LONG UNBEATEN
RECORD WITH 121 GOALS FOR AND ONLY 19 AGAINST

MORE RECENTLY

WE INTERGRATED WHAT WAS FORMERLY KNOWN AS JUNIOR SHOTS TO ASH UNITED YOUTH FC WITH OVER 300 CHILDREN FROM U5 TO U16 PLAYING ACCROSS THE SURREY YOUTH, HANTS & BERKS LEAGUES. WE HOPE THIS CEMENTS A PATHWAY FOR YOUNG PLAYERS TO PROGRESS INTO THE FIRST TEAM

THE RESERVE TEAM FOLLOWED SUIT WINNING THE DIVISION "A" TITLE SCORING 137 GOALS IN ONLY 26 GAMES. WITH THE CLUB HAVING A STRONG SQUAD OF PLAYERS, PROMOTION TO THE SURREY SENIOR LEAGUE WAS ACHIEVED IN 1968. FINISHING RUNNERS UP IN BOTH THE LEAGUE AND THE CUP IN THE FIRST SEASON THEIR FIRST SPELL IN THE SURREY SENIOR LEAGUE CAME TO AN END IN 1971 WHEN BEING FORCED TO CHANGE GROUNDS. ASH UNITED WERE RE-ADMITTED TO THE SURREY SENIOR LEAGUE WHEN A NEW PERMANENT GROUND WAS FOUND. WHICH HAPPENS TO BE THE CURRENT GROUND AT YOUNGS DRIVE. THE SMURFIT KAPPA STADIUM THE NEXT SUCCESSFUL SEASON WAS 1977/78. THEY WON THE CHARITY CUP BEATING DORKING 2-1. THE FOLLOWING SEASON THEY WERE RUNNERS-UP IN BOTH THE NEWLY NAMED COMBINED COUNTIES LEAGUE AND THE PHILIPS FOOTBALL FLOODLIGHTING CUP COMPETITION.

THE APPOINTMENT OF OUR NEW FIRST TEAM MANAGER - OUR RESERVES & U18S ARE RUN BY THE COACHING TEAM (ALEX JUSTIN JOSH & PAUL) MOVE TO THE ALDERSHOT AND DISTRICT LEAGUE - OUR U18 PLAYING IN THE ALLIED COUNTIES U18 MIDWEEK LEAGUE - OUR NEWLY FORMED ASH UNITED WOMEN (MANAGED BY DAN & BLAINE) PLAY IN THE WOMENS SOUTHERN COMBINATION LEAGUE AND WE ALSO HAVE A NEW VETS TEAM RUN







OPPOSITION HISTORY



THE CLUB IS RUN BY A COMMITTED GROUP OF VOLUNTEERS WHO GIVE THEIR TIME AND EFFORT TO SUPPORT THE GIRLS / WOMEN AND KEEP THE CLUB RUNNING ON A NON-PROFIT BASIS.

ALL CLUB OFFICIALS ARE SUBJECT TO DBS CHECKS THROUGH THE SURREY FA AND EACH TEAM HAS AN EXPERIENCED COACH QUALIFIED TO AT LEAST FA LEVEL I WHO WORK VERY CLOSELY WITH THE MANAGERS TO DELIVER THE BEST QUALITY TRAINING AROUND THE AREA.

BEECHOLME BELLES WAS ESTABLISHED IN 2000 BY GARY TUHILL AND RAY WATSON WHO WERE FRUSTRATED AT THE LACK OF OPPORTUNITIES FOR GIRLS TO PLAY COMPETITIVE FOOTBALL.

IN 2002 THERE WERE ENOUGH OTHER LOCAL TEAMS TO JOIN THE BELLES IN THE SURREY COUNTY GIRLS LEAGUE AND THE UNDER 11S AT THAT TIME WENT ON TO WIN THE LEAGUE, LEAGUE CUP AND COUNTY CUP TREBLE! THE UNDER 10 TEAM FOR THAT SEASON - WHICH INCLUDED A NUMBER OF UNDER 8 AND UNDER 9 GIRLS - WENT ON TO BE THE RUNNERS UP.

IN 2012/13 THE UNDER 15S WON THE PREMIER DIVISION AND THE SURREY CUP. THE GIRLS ALSO WON THE REIGATE &

RANSTEAD SPORTS AWARDS FOR THE YOUNG GIRLS TEAM OF THE YEAR

IN 2013/14 GIRLS WERE SELECTED TO PLAY WITH THE SURREY PLAYER DEVELOPMENT CENTRE AND THE SURREY SCHOOLS FOOTBALL ASSOCIATION. OUR UNDER 10S WON AN AWARD FROM ACTIVE SURREY.

IN THE SUMMER OF 2014 THE CLUB WAS AWARDED A GRANT FROM SURREY FA AND A SECOND GRANT FROM THE FOOTBALL FOUNDATION. THIS TOGETHER WITH SUPPORT FROM PARENTS AND A LOT OF HARD WORK FROM OUR COMMITTEE, ALLOWED US TO GROW THE CLUB TO 9 TEAMS FROM USS ALL THE WAY TO UISS.

IN 2014/15 OUR UNDER 18S - MOST OF WHOM WERE U16S / U17S PLAYING UP AN AGE GROUP - WERE THE PREMIER DIVISION CHAMPIONS! MOST OF THE GIRLS HAVE BEEN TOGETHER AS A TEAM SINCE THEY WERE U9S/U10S AND ALL ARE GREAT ROLE MODELS FOR OUR YOUNGER PLAYERS. ONE OF THE GIRLS QUALIFIED AS OUR FIRST PLAYER COACH WITH THE SURREY FA LEVEL 1 COACHING PROGRAMME AND IS PART OF OUR COACHING TEAM FOR THE UNDER 14S.

IN 2015/16 THE U18S WERE THE PREMIER DIVISION CHAMPIONS, WINNERS OF THE SURREY CHALLENGE CUP AND WERE NARROWLY BEATEN BY TOTTENHAM FC IN THE CAPITAL CUP FINAL. WHILST ONLY ALLOWED BY THE FA TO PLAY DEVELOPMENT FOOTBALL' THE YOUNGER BELLES ARE ALREADY FOLLOWING IN THEIR FOOTSTEPS AND HAVE WON TOO MANY TROPHIES AND MEDALS TO LIST IN SUMMER TOURNAMENTS ACROSS SURREY.

DURING THE SEASON TWO OF OUR U18S SQUAD QUALIFIED AS REFEREES WHILST CONTINUING TO PLAY.

IN 2016/17 THE CLUB CONTINUED TO GROW AND AT THE START OF THE SEASON WE HAD A FULL DEVELOPMENT SQUAD AND EVEN A WAITING LIST! THAT TOGETHER WITH OUR TEAMS PLAYING DEVELOPMENT AND COMPETITIVE FOOTBALL INCLUDING TWO TEAMS PLAYING AT U18S - WHEN MANY CLUBS STRUGGLE TO HAVE ONE. THE U15S WERE DIVISION CHAMPIONS AND OUR YOUNGER TEAMS WERE DEVELOPING NICELY WITH ONE OF OUR U11S READY TO PLAY UP A YEAR BUILDING ON THEIR LITTLE LEAGUE EXPERIENCE.

IN 2017/18 U12S WILDCATS ARE DIVISION & CUP CHAMPIONS EVEN BEFORE OTHER TEAMS HAVE FINISHED THEIR SEASON.

SPRING 2018 SAW US AWARDED AN SSE WILDCATS CENTRE TO WORK WITH SURREY FA TO OFFER MORE LOCAL GIRLS THE OPPORTUNITY TO ENJOY SPORT AND IN PARTICULAR, FOOTBALL. OVER 50 GIRLS SIGNED UP BRINGING 3 NEW MEMBERS OF COACHING STAFF INTO THE CLUB - INCLUDING A FORMER BELLE STUDYING AT A LOCAL UNIVERSITY.

BEECHOLME BELLES CONTINUES WITH THE PHILOSOPHY OF PROVIDING QUALITY COACHING IN A SAFE, FRIENDLY AND MOST OF ALL SUPPORTIVE ENVIRONMENT FOR ITS GIRLS. COACHING GIRLS IS DIFFERENT AND WE UNDERSTAND THAT DIFFERENCE AND MAKE IT COUNT TO SUPPORT THE GIRLS.
