ASH HISTORY

ASH UNITED FC WAS FOUNDED IN 1911 AND STARTED PLAYING MATCHES AT ASH COMMON.

THEY SOON BECAME WELL ESTABLISHED IN THE SURREY INTERMEDIATE LEAGUE, WINNING EVERY HONOUR POSSIBLE.

AFTER THE SECOND WORLD WAR ASH UNITED RESTRUCTURED AND THE 1947/48 SEASON WAS THE MOST SUCCESSFUL IN THEIR SHORT HISTORY, WINNING THE LEAGUE CHAMPIONSHIP AND FOUR-CUP COMPETITIONS.

THEY THEN HAD TO WAIT UNTIL THE 1966/67 SEASON FOR THEIR NEXT SUCCESSFUL CAMPAIGN WHERE THEY DOMINATED THE SURREY INTERMEDIATE PREMIER "A" LEAGUE. THE TITLE WAS WON WITH ONLY TWO POINTS DROPPED OUT OF A POSSIBLE FIFTY-TWO. THIS INCLUDED A LONG UNBEATEN RECORD WITH 121 GOALS FOR AND ONLY 19 AGAINST

MORE RECENTLY

WE INTERGRATED WHAT WAS FORMERLY KNOWN AS JUNIOR SHOTS TO ASH UNITED YOUTH FC WITH OVER 300 CHILDREN FROM U5 TO U16 PLAYING ACCROSS THE SURREY YOUTH, HANTS & BERKS LEAGUES. WE HOPE THIS CEMENTS A PATHWAY FOR YOUNG PLAYERS TO PROGRESS INTO THE FIRST TEAM

THE RESERVE TEAM FOLLOWED SUIT WINNING THE DIVISION "A" TITLE SCORING 137 GOALS IN ONLY 26 GAMES. WITH THE CLUB HAVING A STRONG SQUAD OF PLAYERS, PROMOTION TO THE SURREY SENIOR LEAGUE WAS ACHIEVED IN 1968. FINISHING RUNNERS UP IN BOTH THE LEAGUE AND THE CUP IN THE FIRST SEASON THEIR FIRST SPELL IN THE SURREY SENIOR LEAGUE CAME TO AN END IN 1971 WHEN BEING FORCED TO CHANGE GROUNDS.

ASH UNITED WERE RE-ADMITTED TO THE SURREY SENIOR LEAGUE WHEN A NEW PERMANENT GROUND WAS FOUND, WHICH HAPPENS TO BE THE CURRENT GROUND AT YOUNGS DRIVE. THE SMURFIT KAPPA STADIUM THE NEXT SUCCESSFUL SEASON WAS 1977/78. THEY WON THE CHARITY CUP BEATING DORKING 2-1. THE FOLLOWING SEASON THEY WERE RUNNERS-UP IN BOTH THE NEWLY NAMED COMBINED COUNTIES LEAGUE AND THE PHILIPS FOOTBALL FLOODLIGHTING CUP COMPETITION.

THE APPOINTMENT OF OUR NEW FIRST TEAM MANAGER - OUR RESERVES & U18S ARE RUN BY THE COACHING TEAM (ALEX JUSTIN JOSH & PAUL) MOVE TO THE ALDERSHOT AND DISTRICT LEAGUE - OUR U18 PLAYING IN THE ALLIED COUNTIES U18 MIDWEEK LEAGUE - OUR NEWLY FORMED ASH UNITED WOMEN (MANAGED BY DAN & BLAINE) PLAY IN THE WOMENS SOUTHERN COMBINATION LEAGUE AND WE ALSO HAVE A NEW VETS TEAM RUN





OPPOSITION HISTORY



Clanfield FC was formed in 1983 with the merging of Clanfield Seniors and Clanfield Boys Club to establish a single club for the area. In our relatively short history we have built up a strong infrastructure both on and off the pitch and this has enabled us to run teams ranging from boys and girls youth teams up to senior level.

Clanfield FC's home ground has been Peel Park since the club was formed with changes over the years to accommodate the league standards required to play at Hampshire level. Unfortunately, the restrictions at Peel Park mean that progression beyond the Hampshire Premier League required the 1st team to seek an alternative home to play at. In 2019 we agreed a groundshare arrangement with Havant & Waterlooville FC and started putting together plans to secure promotion into the Wessex League.

As a club, our most successful period to date was in the 90's winning the Portsmouth & District League at all levels then joining the Hampshire League in 1997. The club's biggest achievement came in the 1998/99 season with the club winning the Hampshire League Division 3 title and the Hampshire Intermediate Cup completing the double and making history for the club. The club briefly joined the Wessex League in early 2000's until the reformed Hampshire Premier League was introduced for season 2007/08 and that is where the club stayed until we finished 2nd in the 2022/23 season, securing our promotion to the Wessex League Division 1.

Our youth structure has a pathway through from our Colts sessions through to U18s, incorporating 23 youth teams playing in the Portsmouth Youth League, Mid Solent League and Hampshire Girls League. Our U23s and Reserves teams play in the Hampshire Combination and Development League while in 2022/23 we had our first Women's team enter the County Women's league. Our successful Weetabix Wildcats programme has helped create a thriving girls football section, with nearly half our youth members being female, with a number playing for both girls and mixed football teams.

For this season we are delighted to welcome new main kit sponsors to the club in Steve Grantham Bespoke Estate Agent, Jones & Young Mortgage Brokers, Internal Solar, Ship & Bell Horndean and Murray Planning.

WHEN WE STARTED IN THE SUMMER WE ONLY HAD TWO LADS FROM THE PREVIOUS TEAM, MEANING WE HAD TO REBUILD A NEW SQUAD OVER THE SUMMER.

BETWEEN US WE HAVE ASSEMBLED A SQUAD THAT WE BELIEVE WILL PUSH THE CLUB FORWARD, WITH A SOLID FOUNDATION THAT WE ARE EXCITED TO BUILD UPON THIS SEASON.

PRE SEASON HAS BEEN DIFFERENT THIS SEASON, WITH MANY PLAYERS COMING TO TRIAL WITH US. THE BEGINNING WAS A BIT STOP START AS WE HAD MANY DIFFERENT PLAYERS TO CHOOSE FROM, HOWEVER, WE HAVE SELECTED A GOOD, HONEST BUNCH OF LADS WHO WE ARE LOOKING FORWARD TO THIS SEASON WITH.

VELOCITY WESSEX LEAGUE ALCOHOL POLICY

ALL CLUBS, WHERE THE PROVISION OF ALCOHOL IS AVAILABLE, MUST HAVE A CURRENT AUTHORISING LICENCE, FROM THE REGULATORY BODY, AND PROVIDE THE LEAGUE WITH THE TERMS REGARDING THE MEMBERSHIP PROVISIONS.

IRRESPECTIVE OF SUCH, IT IS A LEAGUE DIRECTIVE THAT NO ALCOHOL IS TO BE TAKEN OR CONSUMED, OUTSIDE OF THE LICENSED CLUBHOUSE AREA, IMMEDIATELY BEFORE, DURING AND IMMEDIATELY AFTER, ANY PLAYING PERIOD.

FOR THE AVOIDANCE OF DOUBT AS TO THE AREAS OF THE GROUND COVERED BY THIS DIRECTIVE, EACH CLUB MUST HAVE AUTHORISATION, IN WRITING, BY THE LEAGUE OF THE SPECIFIC AREAS DEEMED TO BE PERMISSIBLE FOR THE CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOL.
