## ASH HISTORY



ASH UNITED FC WAS FOUNDED IN 1911 AND STARTED PLAYING MATCHES AT ASH COMMON.

THEY SOON BECAME WELL ESTABLISHED IN THE SURREY INTERMEDIATE LEAGUE, WINNING EVERY HONOUR POSSIBLE. AFTER THE SECOND WORLD WAR ASH UNITED RESTRUCTURED AND THE 1947/48 SEASON WAS THE MOST SUCCESSFUL IN THEIR SHORT HISTORY, WINNING THE LEAGUE CHAMPIONSHIP AND FOUR-CUP COMPETITIONS.

THEY THEN HAD TO WAIT UNTIL THE 1966/67
SEASON FOR THEIR NEXT SUCCESSFUL
CAMPAIGN WHERE THEY DOMINATED THE
SURREY INTERMEDIATE PREMIER "A"
LEAGUE. THE TITLE WAS WON WITH ONLY
TWO POINTS DROPPED OUT OF A POSSIBLE
FIFTY-TWO. THIS INCLUDED A LONG UNBEATEN
RECORD WITH 121 GOALS FOR AND ONLY 19 AGAINST

MORE RECENTLY .....

WE INTERGRATED WHAT WAS FORMERLY KNOWN AS JUNIOR SHOTS TO ASH UNITED YOUTH FO WITH OVER 300 CHILDREN FROM U5 TO U16 PLAYING ACCROSS THE SURREY YOUTH, HANTS & BERKS LEAGUES. WE HOPE THIS CEMENTS A PATHWAY FOR YOUNG PLAYERS TO PROGRESS INTO THE FIRST TEAM

THE RESERVE TEAM FOLLOWED SUIT WINNING THE DIVISION "A" TITLE SCORING 137 GOALS IN ONLY 26 GAMES. WITH THE CLUB HAVING A STRONG SQUAD OF PLAYERS, PROMOTION TO THE SURREY SENIOR LEAGUE WAS ACHIEVED IN 1968. FINISHING RUNNERS UP IN BOTH THE LEAGUE AND THE CUP IN THE FIRST SEASON THEIR FIRST SPELL IN THE SURREY SENIOR LEAGUE CAME TO AN END IN 1971 WHEN BEING FORCED TO CHANGE GROUNDS. ASH UNITED WERE RE-ADMITTED TO THE SURREY SENIOR LEAGUE WHEN A NEW PERMANENT GROUND WAS FOUND. WHICH HAPPENS TO BE THE CURRENT GROUND AT YOUNGS DRIVE. THE SMURFIT KAPPA STADIUM THE NEXT SUCCESSFUL SEASON WAS 1977/78. THEY WON THE CHARITY CUP BEATING DORKING 2-1. THE FOLLOWING SEASON THEY WERE RUNNERS-UP IN BOTH THE NEWLY NAMED COMBINED COUNTIES LEAGUE AND THE PHILIPS FOOTBALL

THE APPOINTMENT OF OUR NEW FIRST TEAM MANAGER - OUR RESERVES & UIBS ARE RUN BY THE COACHING TEAM (ALEX JUSTIN JOSH & PAUL) MOVE TO THE ALDERSHOT AND DISTRICT LEAGUE - OUR UIB PLAYING IN THE ALLIED COUNTIES UIB MIDWEEK LEAGUE - OUR NEWLY FORMED ASH UNITED WOMEN (MANAGED BY DAN & BLAINE) PLAY IN THE WOMENS SOUTHERN COMBINATION LEAGUE AND WE ALSO HAVE A NEW VETS TEAM RUN

FLOODLIGHTING CUP COMPETITION.







## TOTTON & ELING FOOTBALL CLUB HISTORY

The Club was formed in 1925 as Bramtoco FC from the workforce of the British American Tobacco Company and changed its name to BAT Sports in 1971, the same year as they entered the Hampshire League. They progressed through the Leagues, winning Division Two in 1975 and being Champions of Division One in both 1988 and 1989.

At that time the installation of floodlights, the construction of a small stand and a permanent fixed barrier enabled them to join the Wessex League. An additional stand and covered standing area followed in due course. Since joining the League they have twice reached the third round of the FA Vase, on the second occasion being drawn against AFC Wimbledon. With the weather causing the BAT ground to be unfit the tie was switched to South West London drawing an attendance of nearly 3,000.

Due to the imminent loss of their long serving Southern Gardens home they were forced to drop down a division at the end of the 2006-07 season and continued with their reserve side in Wessex League Division Two at the end of that season and because of a restructuring in the leagues and still having their ground with a new one promised by Linden Homes they were put in Division One and changed their name to Totton and Eling Football Club. They worked hard in getting a side that would compete and were eventually rewarded in 2009 winning the Division One comfortably, with over 100 points and goals regaining Wessex Premier Football again.

The next year we moved to our new and present ground Miller Park at Little Testwood Farm which is adjacent to AFC Totton. We managed to stay in the Premier division until 2015 when with a lack of funds with having no clubhouse and a real lack of people to help, the club got relegated to Division One after a great fightback right till the end of the season which saw us narrowly relegated on the last day of last season.

We have been rebuilding the club over the last couple of seasons with our youth and go again this term in Division 1 with a new Development side and the backing of our Youth section who are the driving force at the club at the moment. We have an U7, U8, U9, U10, 2 U15, U15 & U16 (Girls), D Squad & 1st Team and still growing every year.

The club have just recently signed a 25 year lease on their new ground Miller Park which now gives the club security and a stable footing to build for the future. 2018/2019 saw the club putting down foundations for the future and this is the Millers first taste of FA Competition after a hiatus of four years.

The Millers have resided in Division One of the Wessex League since 2015/16, with a highest placed finish of ninth in 2022/23.

Guys, great to see you all back for the 2025/2026 campaign and hopefully we can push on from such a positive ending to last season.

### VELOCITY WESSEX LEAGUE ALCOHOL POLICY

ALL CLUBS, WHERE THE PROVISION OF ALCOHOL IS AVAILABLE, MUST HAVE A CURRENT AUTHORISING LICENCE, FROM THE REGULATORY BODY, AND PROVIDE THE LEAGUE WITH THE TERMS REGARDING THE MEMBERSHIP PROVISIONS.

IRRESPECTIVE OF SUCH, IT IS A LEAGUE DIRECTIVE THAT NO ALCOHOL IS TO BE TAKEN OR CONSUMED, OUTSIDE OF THE LICENSED CLUBHOUSE AREA, IMMEDIATELY BEFORE, DURING AND IMMEDIATELY AFTER, ANY PLAYING PERIOD.

FOR THE AVOIDANCE OF DOUBT AS TO THE AREAS OF THE GROUND COVERED BY THIS DIRECTIVE. EACH CLUB MUST HAVE AUTHORISATION, IN WRITING, BY THE LEAGUE OF THE SPECIFIC AREAS DEEMED TO BE PERMISSIBLE FOR THE CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOL.
